Andrea is Director of the Safeguarding Program for the Catholic Archdiocese of Perth. At the very heart of the program is the commitment to the principle that children have an absolute right to physical, spiritual and psychological safety at all times, and that the Church, as a Christian institution, should now and into the future be in the forefront of efforts to make this a reality. One in three girls and one in six boys living in Australia will be sexually abused before they turn 18, as such child protection workshops have become a basic essential for those who care for or work with children.

Safeguarding Children

This workshop has been designed to teach agency staff the dynamics and impacts child sexual abuse has on children and will also preview the new Safeguarding Program and Resource titled "Protecting God's Children". The workshop aims to provide agency staff with knowledge required to prevent and detect child sexual abuse and aims to educate participants on the risk factors and the dangers to look out for.
