Street Doctor Dr Inga, nurse Louise and manager Gemma, provide brilliant service to our visitors, assisting them to attend to all their health problems. We work closely with them, ensuing our people get help with both medical and social/domestic issues. Their care and commitment is a real asset to us.

Community Centrelink Simon, Megan, Karen, Neska and all the team are legendary in their pursuit of social justice for their clients at The Shopfront. Their holistic approach ensues the financial stability of our visitors, but also that the big picture is taken into account. Their encouragement and support of the disadvantaged goes beyond their jobs and makes them fit is so perfectly at The Shopfront.
